The enclosed User Manual may kindly be referred to for guidance on accessing and using the chatbot.

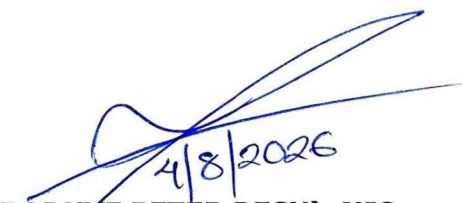

What is Madad?

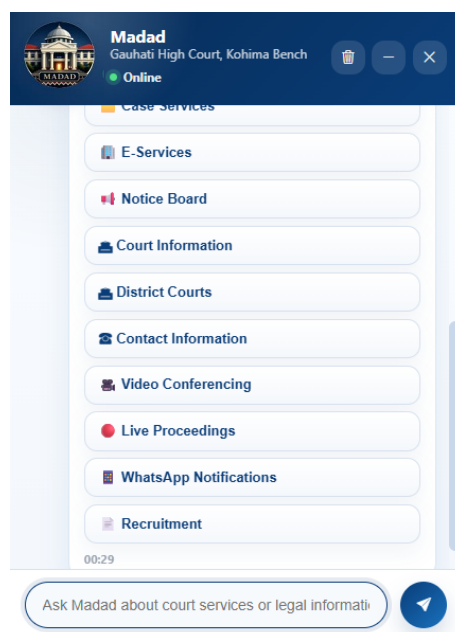
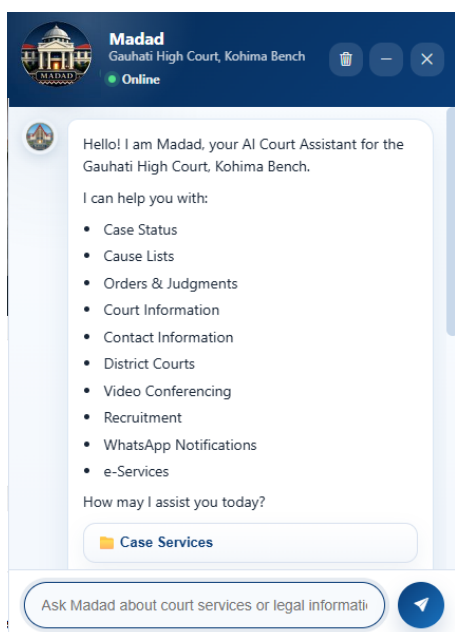
Madad is an AI based chatbot helper on the High Court website. You can have conversation with it like a person. It helps you find court services, official links, information and it answers legal questions.

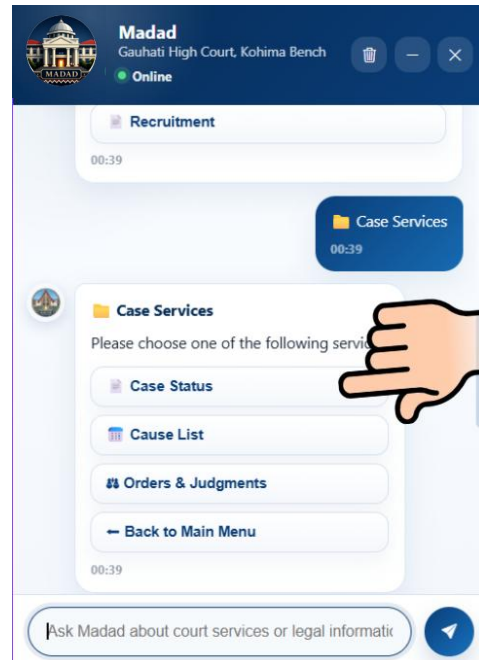
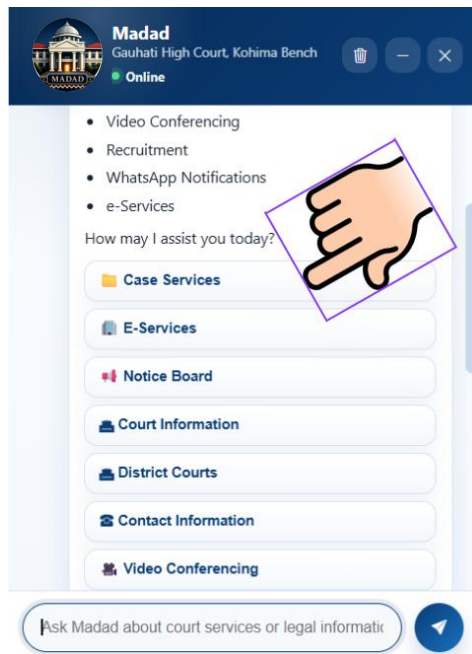
Upon clicking, a chat box will appear along with the main menu.

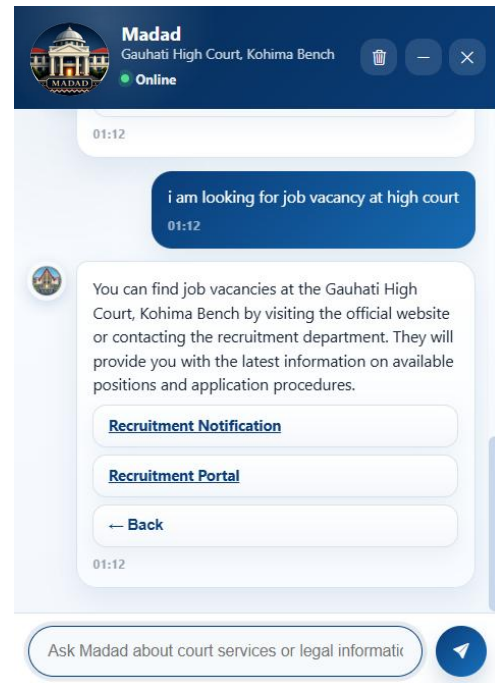

Asking Legal Questions

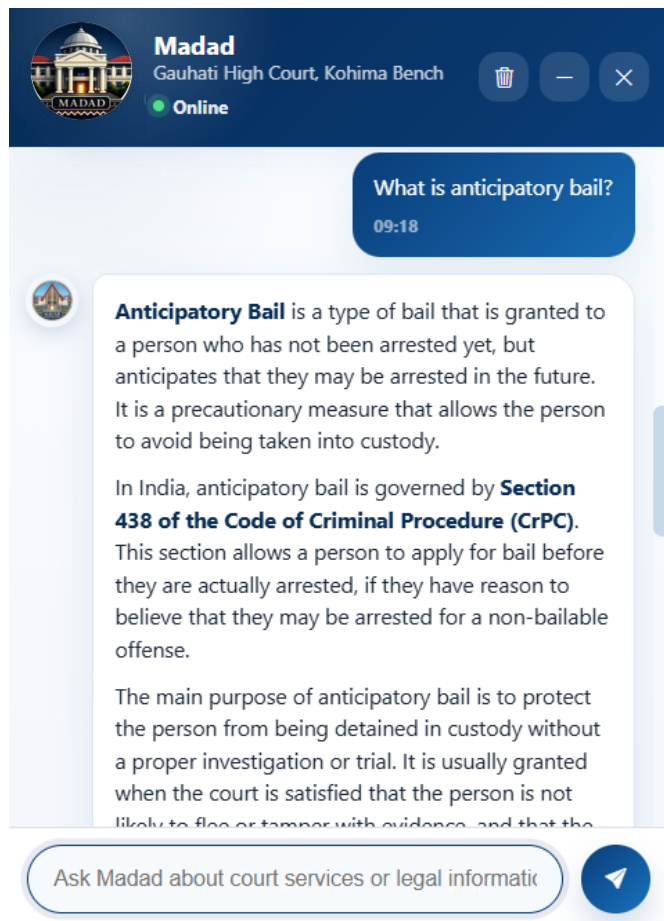
Users can ask legal questions such as:

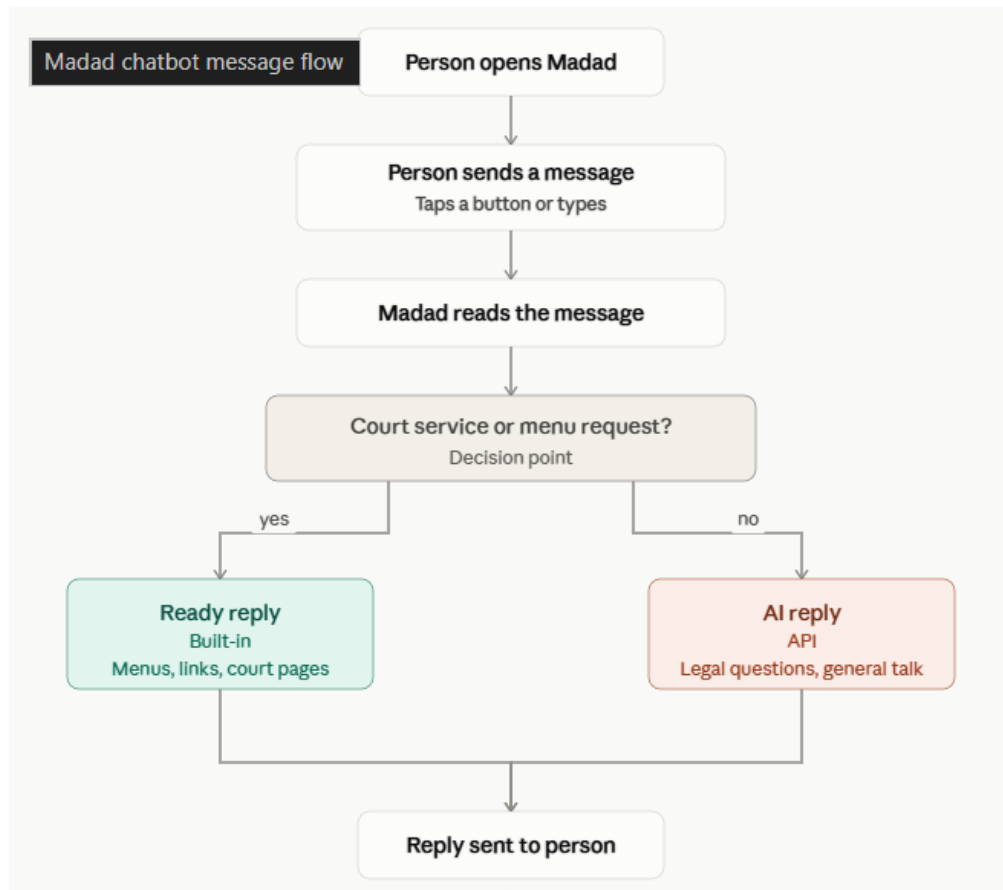
